We have some exciting news! We're about to break ground on a new housing project that will be in the location of lots 22 and 16 near you. This project is set to be completed in July of 2027 and will open the door to house many more students while adding to the overall campus experience.

While the end result will be amazing, getting there might have some ups and downs — we're talking construction. While we strive to make the experience as seamless as possible, **we want to give you a heads-up on what to expect about the construction that will be happening.**

We'll be sending you biweekly emails with all the info you need so you can stay informed and be prepared.

Here's what construction is coming up:

- February 3: Fencing starts
- February 3: Tree removal begins (expect some noise)
- February 10: Demolition begins (expect some noise)

The upcoming rain may shift these dates, but these are our goals for the month. We know how important a quiet environment is for studying, sleeping and so many other activities. **First, we are happy to say that construction will not begin before 7 am and will be done by 3:30 pm each day with noisy work beginning at 8.**

What can you do to prepare for construction noise?
